The objectives of this project are to increase pollinator habitat at the Slider Special Wildlife Habitat Area (Town Creek Site) in Green Ridge State Forest through reducing invasive species and cold season grasses and increasing the coverage of pollen and nectar plants. After meeting with the Green Ridge Forest Manager earlier this summer, we have decided to significantly scale back his involvement in the management portion of the project. This is due to several issues including limitations imposed by COVID-19, problems with existing equipment, and issues that have prevented us from obtaining new equipment necessary to carry out the original management objectives. We will still be conducting bee and vegetation surveys and will continue managing the 2-acre pollinator meadow (8B). We will also manage the surrounding units if time and staff permit but will not likely follow the original timeline. During the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter we reviewed and coordinated moth survey protocols and plans for 2021 but no active management activities were conducted. DNR Forest Service management activities were and continue to be severely restricted due to COVID-19 teleworking requirements, and only timber operations are currently permitted.

Were planned goals/objectives achieved last quarter? Yes; plans for the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter were limited to reviewing moth survey protocols and coordinating moth surveys for 2021.

<u>Difficulties Encountered</u>: Management activities continue to be precluded due to restrictions imposed by COVID-19.
