The objectives of this project are to increase pollinator habitat at the Furnace and Foster Tracts of Pocomoke State Forest through increasing the acreage of early successional habitat, increasing the coverage of pollen and nectar plants, and removing less desirable species including planted loblolly pine, maple and sweet gum. During the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2020 we completed fall bee surveys at both the Furnace and Foster Tracts; semi-permanently marked the start and end points of all nine vegetation transects at both tracts with painted rebar (previously they had only been marked with flags); and reviewed/coordinated moth survey protocols/plans for both tracts. DNR Forest Service management activities were and continue to be severely restricted due to COVID-19 teleworking requirements, and only timber operations are currently permitted.

Were planned goals/objectives achieved last quarter? Due to the COVID-19 restrictions, we had limited our planned activities for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter to bee surveys, which were completed. All proposed burns were postponed to a later date TBD.

<u>Progress Achieved</u>: (For each Goal/Objective, list Planned and Actual Accomplishments) We completed fall bee surveys at both the Furnace and Foster Tracts; semi-permanently marked the start and end points of all nine vegetation transects at both tracts with painted rebar; reviewed/coordinated moth survey plans for both tracts (which should begin in 2021); completed quarterly reports.

<u>Difficulties Encountered</u>: Management activities continue to be precluded due to restrictions imposed by COVID-19.

<u>Activities Anticipated Next Quarter</u>: We will re-evaluate management options if current restrictions are lifted, but currently there are no specific activities planned for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2021 due to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions.
